# Summit by Olson Kundig penthouse becomes one of highest-priced condos in Arizona at \$10.3 million

The pinnacle of luxury Sonoran Desert living, the Summit Residences at Ascent are nestled at the base of iconic Camelback Mountain in one of the most prestigious and sought-after locations in the state. Replay Destinations, the developer of Ascent, has engaged the world-renowned firm [Olson Kundig](#) to design the final phase of the new private gated community. Among its limited collection of signature penthouses, the crown jewel will be Penthouse 1301 – a one-of-a-kind masterpiece with Olson Kundig’s distinctive integrated architecture and interior design.

Spanning over 6,200 square feet of seamless indoor and outdoor living spaces, the top-floor residence sets a new standard for design and luxury living in the market. With three bedrooms, a spacious multi-media room and three and a half baths, the penthouse will boast expansive floor-to-ceiling glass walls that fully pocket and retract leaving unimpeded views of Camelback Mountain, the Papago Buttes and the surrounding Valley.

Designed for entertaining, Penthouse 1301 features a refined chef’s kitchen designed in collaboration between bulthaup and Olson Kundig, complemented by a signature back kitchen and an outdoor kitchen with wet bar. Four separate fire features, including those in the primary bedroom, living room and on the expansive terrace, elevate the ambiance throughout. A stunning wine wall, available as a customizable feature, adds a dramatic centerpiece to the home. Premium details such as hardwood flooring, natural stone, Waterworks fixtures, Tom Kundig Collection hardware and Sub-Zero/Wolf appliances are thoughtfully integrated to create the ultimate condominium residence.

“Penthouse 1301 reflects our core design approach, which grounds architecture within its surrounding context,” said Kirsten Ring Murray, principal and owner of Olson Kundig. “Here, that includes Camelback Mountain and the Valley, and this home is the only residence to offer views of both, as well as overlooking the adjacent Mountain Club pool. Throughout the home, opportunities to maximize connections to the landscape result in curated zones for entertaining and spaces that open to the environment for a seamless indoor-outdoor flow. The primary suite, positioned to capture the city lights, also captures those unparalleled views while framing a more tranquil, private space.”
